## OUTDOOR SITE WORK UPDATE

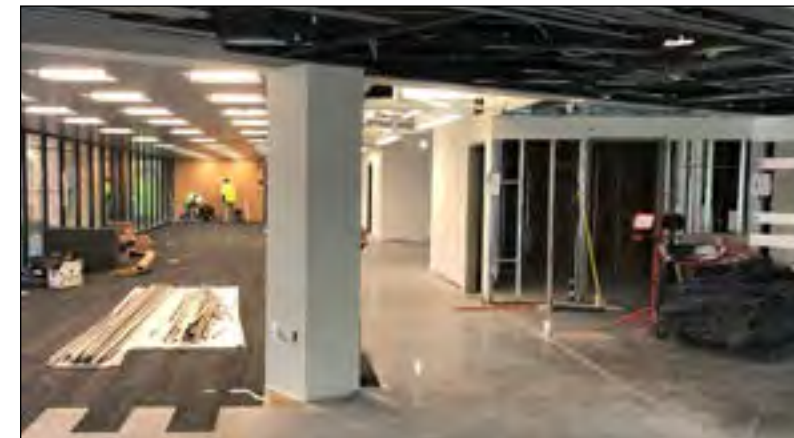
