Black Life in America: The experience and impact of African Americans as recorded by the news media

From the early days of slavery to modern times, people of African descent have had a profound impact on American history. This primary source collection offers an expansive window into centuries of African American history, culture and daily life—as well as the ways the dominant culture has portrayed and perceived people of African descent.

Where does the content come from?

The content in this database is sourced from more than 19,000 American and global news sources, including over 400 current and historical Black publications. It covers the pre-Revolution America to the modern era.

These awards have honored women who have made important contributions to our community and have celebrated the important role that women have played in Pueblo's history.

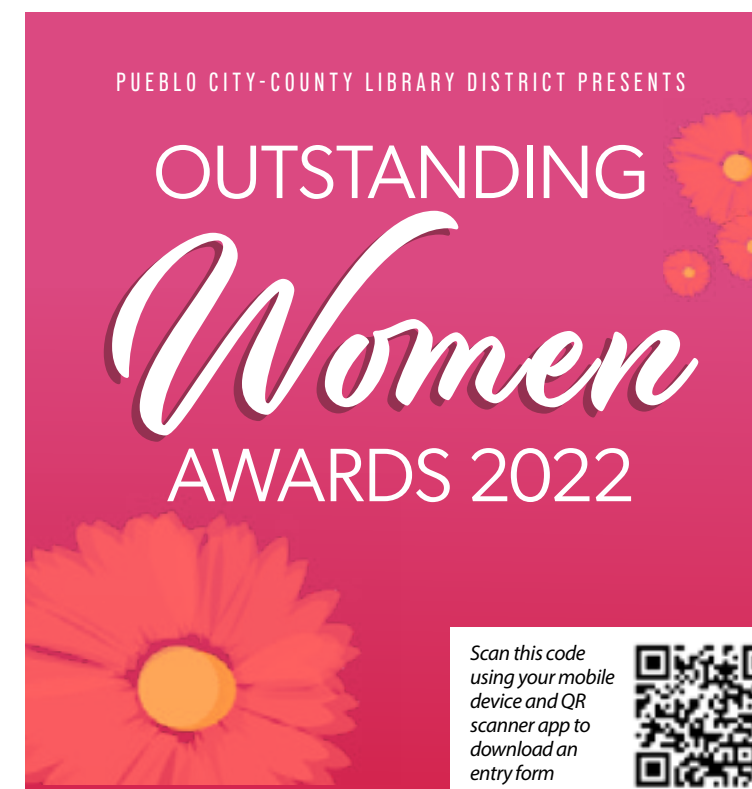

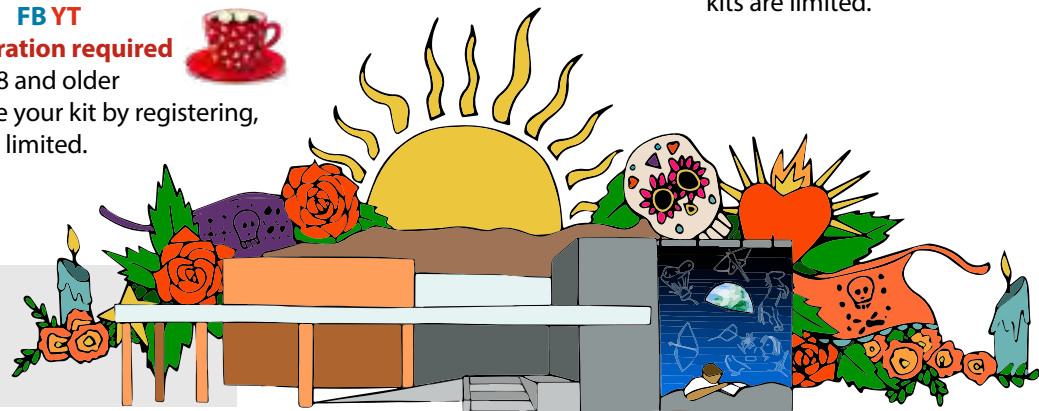

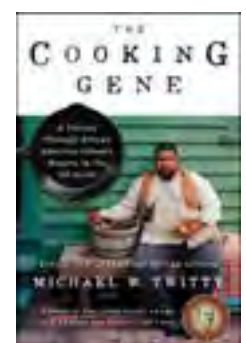
