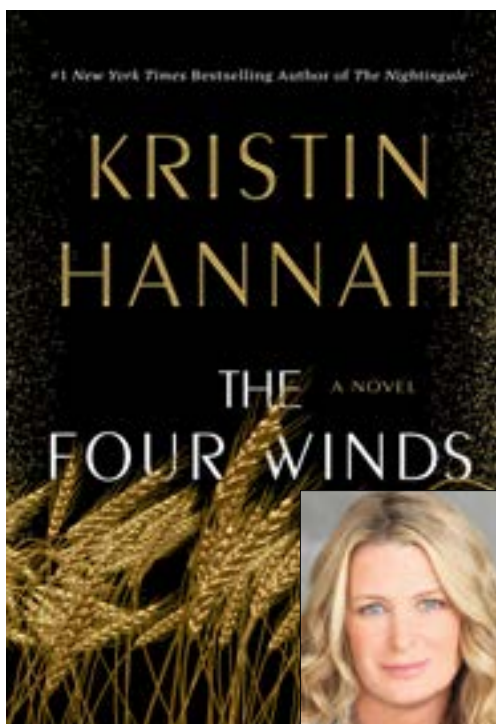

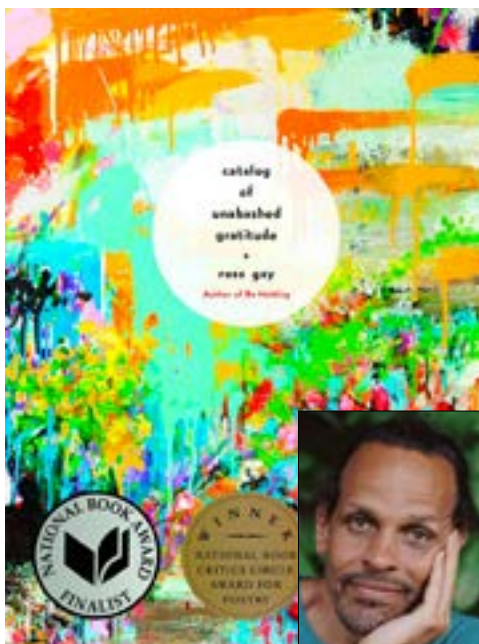

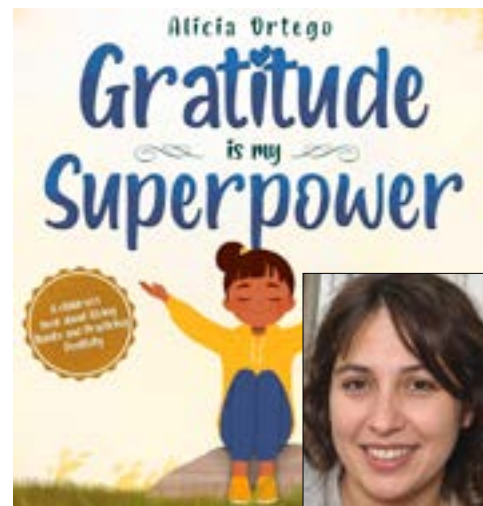

Mental wellness is as important now as ever, which is why the 2022 NEA Big Read All Pueblo Reads is built upon giving readers an outlet to cope with life’s ups and downs.

This year’s literacy project features three distinct authors: Kristin Hannah, author of this year’s selected book *The Four Winds*; NEA sponsored poet Ross Gay, author of *Catalog of Unabashed Gratitude*; and children’s author Alicia Ortego, featuring her series *My Superpower*.

The NEA Big Read All Pueblo Reads project provides classroom sets of books by authors Ross Gay and Alicia Ortego to students in Pueblo schools, hosts six weeks of free activities at all eight library branches and brings bestselling author

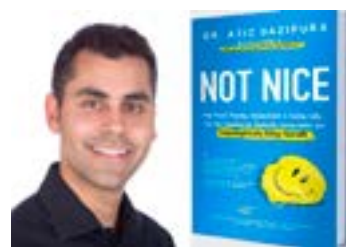

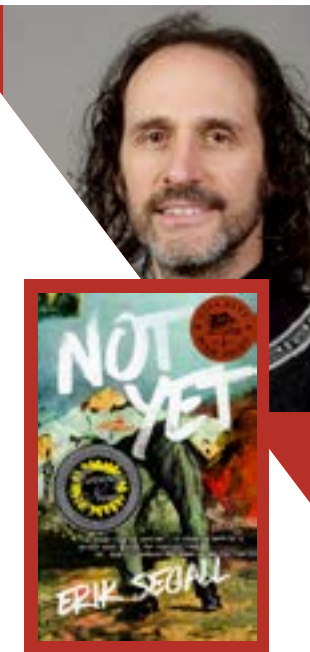
