



30th Pueblo Women's History Week Outstanding Women's Awards for 2012

Pueblo City-County Library District is now accepting nominations for the Outstanding Women's Awards. All community groups are welcome to participate. The purpose of the program is to record and promote the role women have played in Pueblo's history. Toward this goal, the rules for nomination are simple. The woman must be a resident of Pueblo County currently or during the time the award honors. The person does not have to be living to be honored. The awards will be presented during Women's History Week, at the Outstanding Women's Awards luncheon on Friday, March 9 at noon. Auxiliary aides and interpreter services are available, with a one-week notice, to individuals with disabilities by calling 553-0227.

GUIDELINES

1. The woman must be a resident of Pueblo County either now or during the time the award honors.
2. Nominations must be sponsored by a Pueblo organization, club, association, individual, etc.
3. The nominating organization is responsible for preparing a brief biographical sketch of 100-200 words describing the woman's accomplishments. The form will be added to the Robert Hoag Rawlings Library's Western Research Room, and a brief summary will be included on a handout that will be distributed at the luncheon. If possible, please include a photograph. Past recipients will not receive a second award.
4. A representative of the nominating organization will present the award at a special luncheon on Friday, March 9 at noon. The award ceremony will be brief so that women who work may attend.
5. The nominating organization will pay \$56.11 for the award [\$40.00] and the honoree's lunch [\$16.11].
6. The Women's History Week Committee will not judge the entries. The person you choose to honor will be honored.

Nominations must be received by Friday, Feb. 3, 2012 at 5 p.m. The nominations may be mailed or delivered to the Community Relations Dept. at the Pueblo City-County Library District's Robert Hoag Rawlings Library, 100 E. Abriendo Ave., Pueblo, CO 81004.
