III. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Resolutions to Adopt the 2014 Annual Plan, the 2014 Budget, Set the Mill Levy, and Appropriate Sums of Money for the 2014 Budget

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: The Preliminary 2014 Annual Plan and Budget were presented for Board consideration in October, and a Public Hearing was held in November. The Board will be asked to take the following actions:

- a. Approve the 2014 Annual Plan
- b. Adopt the 2014 Budget
- c. Set the mill levy at 5.258 mills
- d. Appropriate funds for the 2014 Budget.

B. PCCLD Property and Liability Insurance Renewal

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: PCCLD's Property and Liability Insurance coverage is scheduled to expire at the end of 2013. The insurance consultants have solicited information for coverage renewal. The best and lowest proposal is at a rate of \$58,447.34 for the year. By policy, this requires Trustee approval since it exceeds \$25,000.

C. PCCLD Workers' Compensation Renewal

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: PCCLD's Workers' Compensation renewal is due in early January. The quoted rate annual renewal for 2014 is \$27,540.49. By policy, this requires Trustee approval since it exceeds \$25,000.

D. SirsiDynix Software Renewal

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: The Board of Trustees will discuss the renewal of the SirsiDynix ILS software at a cost of \$66,544.67. By policy, this requires Trustee approval since it exceeds \$25,000.

E. Video Streaming

OVERVIEW: PCCLD recently procured the technical capability to video stream programs and events. The equipment came courtesy of a grant from the Friends of the Library. The opportunity for live video streaming of Trustee Board meetings will be discussed.

F. Newsletter Articles - Updated Schedule

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: On the recommendation of the Advocacy Committee, the Trustees have been regularly submitting articles for the Library newsletter. An updated schedule will be provided for discussion.

G. Executive Director Evaluation
