A. Trustee Work Session Meeting Date, November 2013

B. Pueblo City-County Library District Board Appointment

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: The Pueblo County Board of Commissioners' office has been in contact with PCCLD, stating that Donna Pickman's reappointment to a full five-year term of office is forthcoming, assuming she applies. Ms. Pickman first joined as a member of the Board of Trustees in May following appointment by the City and the County. She is filling out the term of the previous office holder, who resigned earlier in the year.

C. Naming of the East Side Library

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: The City of Pueblo has committed contributions of approximately \$166,059 to the East Side Library project to date. The PCCLD Board of Trustees authorized that naming rights for the library would go to an entity or individual with a contribution of \$150,000. There is interest in naming the library for a choice by City Council.

D. Pay for Performance: Compensation tied to Key Results

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: The Pueblo City-County Library District has established a goal for 2014 to move to a Pay-for-Performance system. A preliminary report on this project will be provided.
