## All Pueblo Reads 2016: Water for Elephants by Sara Gruen

2016 was a record breaker! This year's All Pueblo Reads project featured *Water for Elephants* by Sara Gruen. The companion book for young people was *Out of the Dust* by Karen Hesse. 170 events and activities were held with 18 community partners. All programs, events and activities tied in with circus, the 1930s, The Great Depression, animals and other themes of the book.

2016 Booklovers Blacktie Ball

To expand last year's effort to get kids reading, more than 1,200 free copies of *Out of the Dust* were given to local students. New for this year was the addition of the companion book author. More than 650 attended three

presentations by Karen Hesse. Also new this year was the deliberate focus on family programming. The most successful APR event ever (outside of the public author events) was the Family Circus Festival and Fun, which had 400 in attendance. The philosophical approach to this year's programming was to have less events, but more attendees per event.

## **Booklovers Blacktie Ball and Public Event**

Several innovations were made to this year's Booklovers Blacktie Ball, which helped it to be the most financially successful ball in history.

Advanced purchase pricing for \$75 led to a larger reservation count a full month before the event. This not only incentivized guests to make reservations sooner (the price moved to \$100 after the early reservation date), it made planning and managing the event much easier for staff. Several new ticket-levels were introduced including premium seating for \$100 (closer to the stage) and author-table tickets at \$250 (more than double the regular price).

The ball had its second highest attendance ever, 217. Ticket sales were \$15,150, sponsorships were \$18,550, silent auction proceeds were \$3,788 and additional donations were \$250.
