- Grades 3-5 400 word minimum, 700 word maximum
- Grades 6-12 1,000 word minimum, 1,200 word maximum
- Do not place student's name on any page of story.
- Provide one copy of entry with entry form on top.
- All entries must be typed in 12 point type using Times New Roman or Courier New and double spaced.
- Place title on top of first page no title page needed.
- Number each page.

Any entry not containing the above phrase and all six words, <u>underlined</u> for easy identification, will be disqualified.

Judging: Entries will be judged by the Friends of the Library. All entries will receive a certificate of participation.

First , second & third place prizes: Gift certificate to Books Again, the Friends of the Library used bookstore, a Certificate of Merit, and a booklet with all of the winning stories.
