## How it Works

The Reveal will take place at 11 a.m. on Saturday, Sept. 14 at the Rawlings Library. Filmmakers will receive instructions & required film elements. Everyone will then have 24 hours to shoot, edit and submit their film. **ALL FILMS MUST BE SUBMITTED** between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 15 at Sangre de Cristo Arts Center, 210 N. Sante Fe Ave.

Films will be viewed and judged at two screenings. Awards will be given immediately following the screenings.

## Film Requirements

- Films must be no longer than 7 minutes
- At least one scene must be filmed at the randomly chosen location provided at the reveal.
- Films must include (either spoken or seen) the quote announced at the reveal.
- Films must incorporate props given at the reveal.
- Films must be submitted by 11 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 15 at the Sangre de Cristo Arts Center.
- Filmmakers must have permission from the owner to use any sound tracks or film clips.
- Films must be submitted as playable DVD/Blu-ray or on a DVD disk containing the following media file formats that can be played from a computer: Windows Media (WMV), Quicktime (MOV), Microsoft Video Format (AVI) or H.264 Compressed Movie
- Videos are acceptable in either the standard definition (720 wide x 480 tall) or in HD format (1920 wide x 1080 tall.) Preferred format is H.264 compressed HD (1920x1080) progressive at 24fps with sound at 48kHz sampling rate.
- Only films that meet the above requirements will be eligible for an award.

## Registration

Please register by Friday, Sept. 6. Late registrations will be accepted up until 11 a.m. on Saturday, Sept. 14. There is no cost to register. Filmmakers must be under 18 or enrolled in a Pueblo County elementary, middle or high school.
