Who is your favorite animal? Write an adventure story starring your favorite animal! Your animal can be real, fictional or historic.

Each entry must comply with these guidelines:

The last paragraph of the story must contain this exact phrase: "Some animals are extraordinary."

Each story must contain the following words anywhere in the story exactly as given (for example "wrinkle" but not "wrinkled"):

friend	<u>clever</u>	ascend
tricks	saved	quickly

Any entry not containing the above phrase and all six words, <u>underlined</u> for easy identification, will be disqualified.

Contest Guidelines



- Grades 3-5 400 word minimum, 700 word maximum
- Grades 6-12 1,000 word minimum, 1,200 word maximum
- Do not place student's name on any page of story.
- Provide one copy of entry with entry form on top.
- All entries must be typed in 12 point type using Times New Roman or Courier New and double spaced.
- Place title on top of first page no title page needed.
- Number each page in top right-hand corner.

Judging: Entries will be submitted to the Friends of the Pueblo City-County Library District. First, second, and third places will be awarded in each category. All entrants will be recognized.

First , second & third place prizes: Gift certificate to Books Again, the Friends of the Library used book store, Certificate of Merit, and story printed in a booklet. All winners will be honored at a special ceremony on Thursday, Dec. 5, 2013. Auxiliary aides and interpreter services are available, with a one-week notice, to individuals with disabilities by calling 553-0227.

Entry Due Date: Entries are due on Friday, Nov. 1, 2013. Winners will be notified in November and invited to the special awards ceremony.
