OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE KIDS PARADE

- 1. All applications will be reviewed by the Kids Parade Committee. Committee reserves the right to accept or deny any entry.
- 2. A full description of entry MUST be provided. No changes can be made without notification.
- 3. No one born before Aug. 31, 2005 (twelve and under) will be allowed to participate in the parade in a competitive entry.
- 4. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 5. NO 2, 3 OR 4 WHEEL "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES" OR ELECTRIC CARS WILL BE ALLOWED
- 6. Pedal bikes are welcomed!

SAFETY

- 1. Participants shall exercise all precautions for the safety of others and shall be responsible for their own entry.
- 2. In order to properly line up the entries, you must list on the entry form any live animals or sound effects that will be used.
- 3. Nothing may be thrown or handed out to spectators along parade route. (i.e., candy)
- 4. Directions issued by parade officials and law enforcement officials must be obeyed.

GENERAL

- 1. No persons shall ride in autos, trucks, vans, or similar vehicles in the allowed in the parade.
- 2. No-show entries cause serious problems in the line-up. Please let the Kids Parade Committee know at least three days prior to the parade if you wish to cancel your entry.
- 3. All entries are responsible for their own decorations, etc.
- 4. ALL ENTRIES REPORT TO CHECK-IN TABLE ON THE CENTER ISLAND OF ABRIENDO AVE. AND JACKSON ST. CHECK-IN BEGINS AT 8 A.M. ENTRIES SHOULD CHECK IN NO LATER THAN 9 A.M. THOSE CHECKING IN AFTER 9 A.M. WILL BE PUT AT THE END OF THE PARADE. THE PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 10 A.M.
- 5. Late arrivals will not be judged.

JUDGING

- 1. All competitive entries must be in their assigned position no later than 9 a.m.
- 2. Trophies will be awarded at the start of the parade. Winners should display their trophies along the parade route.
- 3. Decision of the judges is final.
