The Friends of the Pueblo City-County Library District invite students in grades 3-12 to enter a short-story writing contest.



Topic: The year is 2075. What does a day in your life look like?

The last paragraph of the story must contain this exact phrase: "The future holds unlimited possibilities!"

Each story must contain the following words anywhere in the story exactly as given (for example "wrinkle" but not "wrinkled"):

gadget peculiar forthcoming
innovate robotic automation

Contest Guidelines

- Grades 3-5 - 400 word minimum, 700 word maximum
- Grades 6-12 - 1,000 word minimum, 1,200 word maximum
- **Do not place student's name on any page of story.**
- Provide one copy of entry with entry form on top.
- All entries must be typed in 12 point type using Times New Roman or Courier New and double spaced.
- Place title on top of first page - no title page needed.
- Number each page in top right-hand corner.

Any entry not containing the above phrase and all six words, underlined for easy identification, will be disqualified.

Judging: Entries will be judged by the Friends of the Library. All entries will receive a certificate of participation.

First , second & third place prizes: Gift certificate to Books Again, the Friends of the Library used book store, a Certificate of Merit, and story printed in the winners booklet.

Awards ceremony: Wednesday, Dec. 9 at 7 p.m. at the Rawlings Library, Ryals room - 4th floor.
