



## Zinio Downloadable Magazines


Zinio is a new downloadable magazine service provided by the Pueblo City-County Library District to Pueblo County Resident Library cardholders. Zinio allows you to sign up and receive downloadable issues of many popular magazines each month. You will need to use your library card to create an account and select publications through the PCCLD Zinio website. New issues will be delivered each month once a publication has been added to your account.

### I. Creating Accounts and Selecting Publications Online

Zinio runs best on Firefox  or Google Chrome. 

To begin visit the Pueblo City-County Library District's Zinio website at:

If this is your first time using the website select the Create Account button. Returning users can select Log In to sign into the website.

### Step 1: Create PCCLD Zinio account and log in

You will now need to create a log in to sign into the PCCLD Zinio website.

1. Enter your full Library Card\* Number without spaces or dashes. Click Validate
2. Enter your email address, create a password, and type your name in the appropriate boxes.
3. Check your email for a validation link to complete your sign up.

**\* Only Pueblo County Residents are able to access this resource.**

Once you have successfully validated your account you can return to the PCCLD Zinio website (<http://www.rbdigital.com/puebloco/zinio>) to log in.

## Step 2: Search for publications

After logging in click on a publication from the alphabetical list or search for a title. Currently PCCLD subscribes to over 75 publications in Zinio.

Search by title with the Search Box.

Click here, to browse available Back Issues.

Browse for a title by using the Alphabetical List.

Back issues are available for check out. Please note that we only have back issues are available for as long as the library have held a subscription to a magazine.



Once you have located a publication click on the cover and click check out.



To read your magazine in your web browser, select “start reading.” Your browser will now open a new tab that will take you to the commercial Zinio website.



### Step 3: Create a Zinio account to subscribe

If you have not used the Zinio magazine service before you will need to create a separate account that can be used on the Zinio apps, on your computer, and to read magazines online. This account information should be the same as the PCCLD Zinio account log in you created in step 1 (You will just need to enter that information again in this form).



Returning users who have already registered with Zinio can click here to sign in.

Your email address will need to match the email address you used to access the PCCLD Zinio website.

Click Continue to complete the Zinio sign up. This will complete adding the title to your account.


A new window will display showcasing all of the publications you are currently receiving through Zinio. Click on the cover of the publication to read it online.




To view or edit your reading list, select “Your Library.”



To delete magazine, select “edit your reading list.”



Click the red X to delete or mark as read. When you are finished, click “done.”

## II. Downloading to a Mobile Device

To download a publication to your mobile device you will need to setup the Zinio app on your device. Only mobile devices that support the Zinio app will be able to have issues downloaded to them. Check with your devices manufacturer to see if a Zinio app is available to you. If an app is not available you can still view issues online through your device's web browser.



Begin by downloading the Zinio app from your devices app store

After the Zinio app is installed on your device open it.

Tap the app's settings menu to log into Zinio with the Zinio account information you created in Step 3 above.

Click on the Read menu option to display and download your publications. You will only use the Zinio app to read your magazines. If you attempt to shop in the app you will be prompted to buy using your own funds. To check out magazines go to the Pueblo City-County Library District's Zinio website in your web browser at:
