LEGISLATIVE AND GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: The PCCLD Legislative and Government Committee (hereafter referred

to as the Committee) shall be established as a standing committee by the Pueblo City-County Library District Board of Trustees to inform the trustees of developments regarding federal, state and local matters affecting library financing and services, such as Tax Increment Financing,

and to advocate on behalf of the library district on these matters.

MEMBERSHIP: Membership shall consist of a minimum of two library trustees (one being

the Board President), the PCCLD Executive Director and community members. Additional trustees may be appointed by the Board President

as needed.

APPOINTMENT: The President of the PCCLD Board of Trustees shall annually appoint the

members of the Committee.
