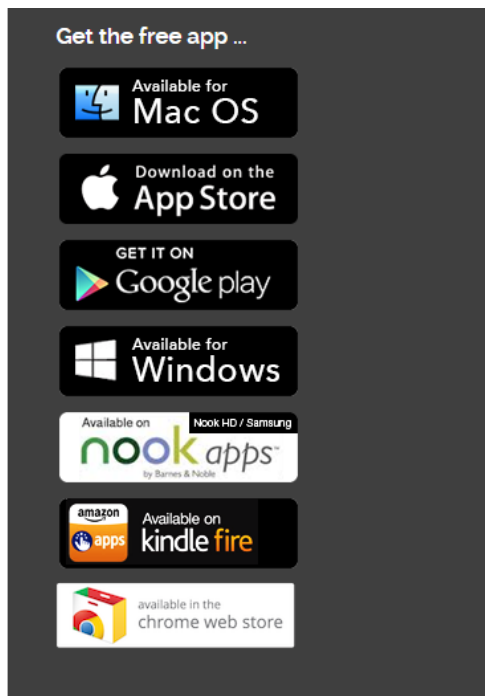


PC setup and NOOK transfer

Computer Setup

Open your internet browser and navigate to <http://www.yourcloudlibrary.com/>



On the left side of the screen locate the area titled “Get the free app...”

Click on the button for the type of computer or device you are setting up. In this example we will click on the Available for Windows button. Mac users will want to click on the Mac OS button instead.

After clicking on one of the options above a webpage outlining the computer system requirements will display. If your computer meets the system requirements scroll down and then click on the Download App button:

Follow the prompts to download and install the application.

Once the application is installed open the program. Some computers may automatically open the program after installation completes. If the program does not open automatically locate and double click on the 3M Cloud Library icon on the desktop.

Once the application opens you will also be prompted to either enter an existing Adobe ID or have 3M create a new one for you. Click Activate to complete the setup.

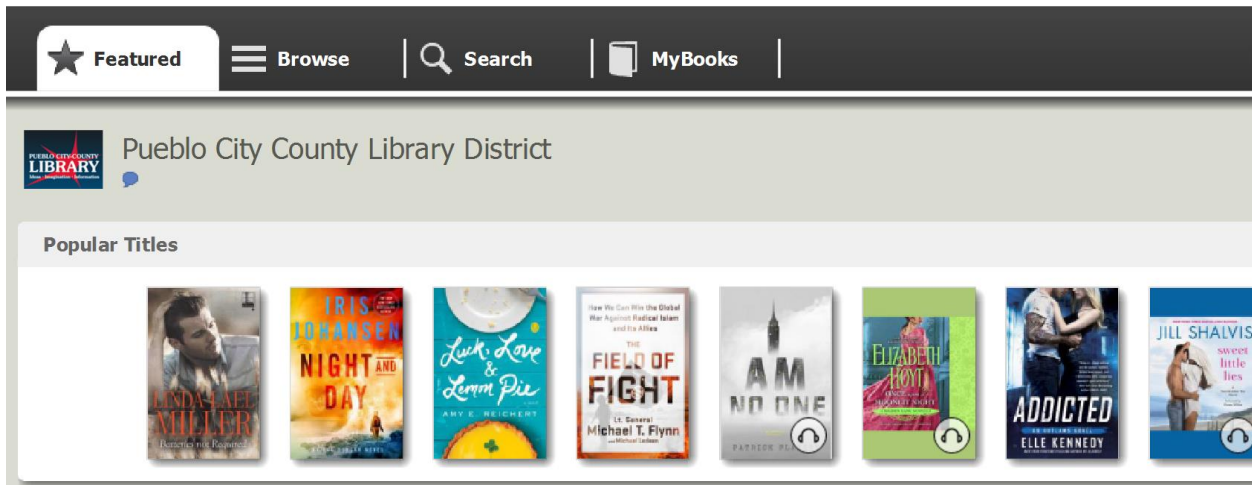



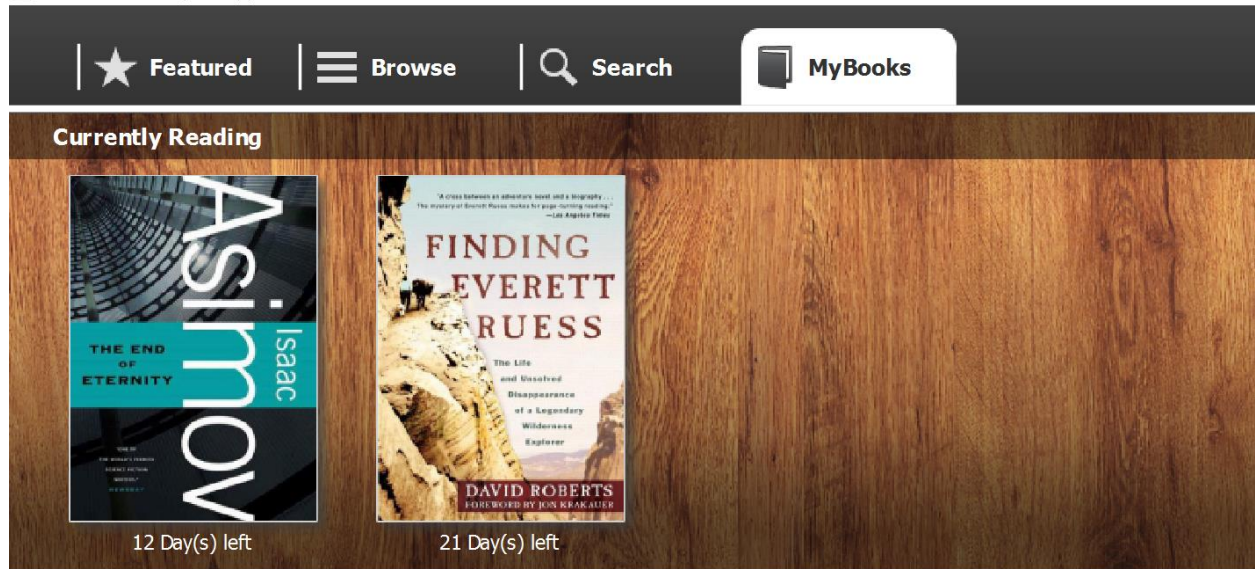
"I have not tired of the wilderness; rather I enjoy its beauty and the vagrant life I lead, more keenly all the time. I prefer the saddle to the street car and the star sprinkled sky to a roof, the obscure and difficult trail, leading into the unknown, to any paved highway, and the deep peace of the wild to the discontent bred by cities." So Everett Ruess wrote in his last letter to his brother. And earlier, in a valedictory poem, *"Say that I starved; that I was lost and weary; That I was burned and blinded by the desert sun; Foolsore, thirsty, sick with strange diseases; Lonely and wet and cold . . . but that I kept my dream!"*

Wandering alone with burros and pack horses through California and the Southwest for five years in the early 1930s, on voyages lasting as long as ten months, Ruess also became friends with photographers Edward

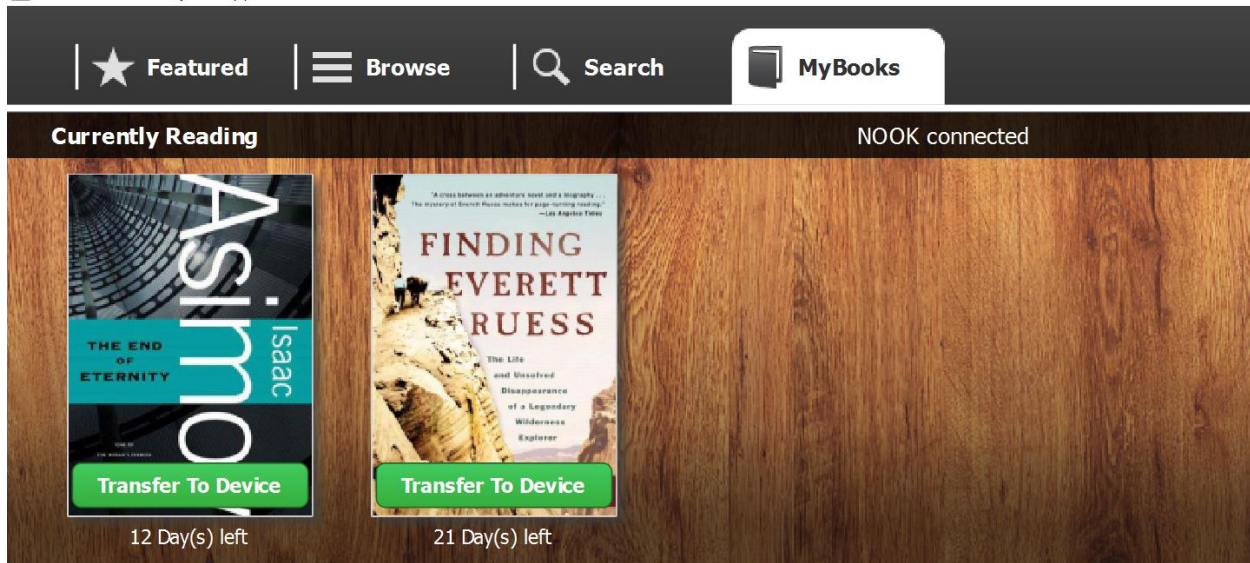


You can read the book on your PC by double clicking on the cover. You can also transfer the book to your NOOK (continue on next page).

NOOK Transfer Instructions:

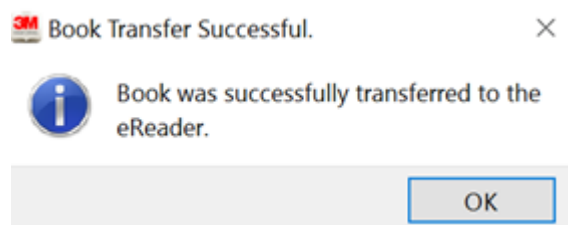
Plug your Nook E-Reader into the computer using the USB cord provided with your NOOK. The Transfer To Device button will display on the cover of the book after the NOOK has been connected.

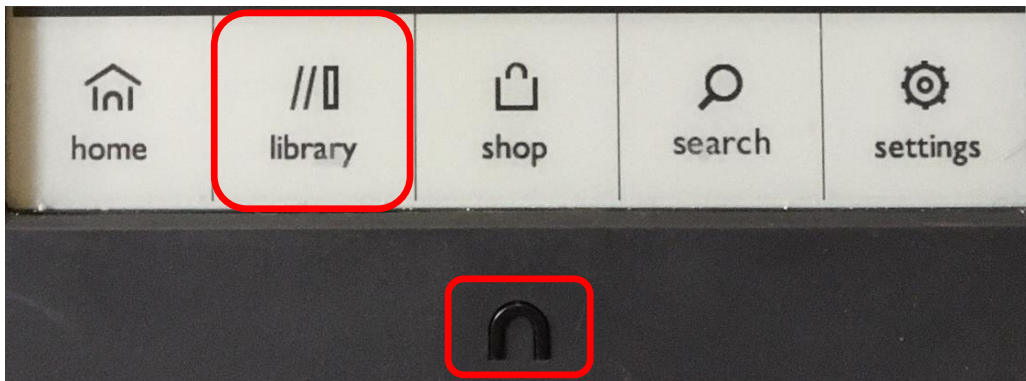
Click on the Transfer To Device button for each book you want to load onto your Nook.

After the transfer is complete a confirmation will display on the computer. Click OK to add another book.

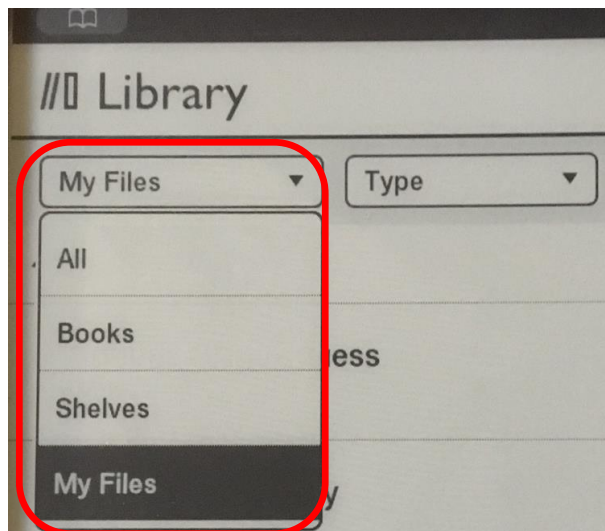


Once you have transferred all of your books you can disconnect your NOOK from the computer.

Now turn on and unlock your NOOK. Press the NOOK button located under your screen. A menu should then appear on the bottom of the screen.

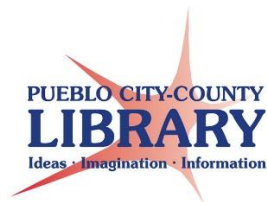
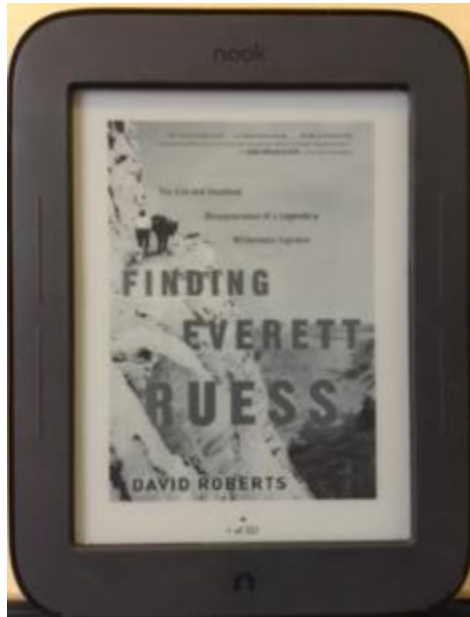


Tap on the Library menu option displayed on the screen. The NOOK's library will now display. To view your library e-books locate the first drop down menu. Make sure My Files is selected. If My Files is not selected tap on it to select it.



You should see a list of the files on your NOOK. On some NOOK devices the e-books will appear by title in the My Files area. If your books are not listed look for a folder titled Adobe Digital Editions or Digital Editions. Open the Digital Editions Folder to see a list of book titles.

Tap on the name of your book to open and read
