Pueblo 24-Hour Film Festival challenges filmmakers of all ages

(PUEBLO, Colo.—Nov. 7, 2012) Got a video camera, a relentless urge to create cinematic art and a good supply of caffeine? Then get those creative juices flowing for the 5^{th} Annual Pueblo 24-Hour Film Festival for adults and youth Nov. 10-11.

Registration

Adult participants must register by the time of the reveal on Nov. 10. The cost to register is \$20, or \$10 if registered by Nov. 7. Young filmmakers must also register, and registration is free. They may register at the Arts Center or the Rawlings Library, via the community relations department on the third floor. Students must be under 18 or enrolled in a Pueblo County elementary, middle or high school to enter the Youth Filmmakers Division.
