Stolen Valor Act discussed at Rawlings Library

Pueblo, Colo. — Pamla Sterner will speak about the Stolen Valor Act, how a policy analysis paper and media coverage helped shape the law and get it passed. This presentation will take place on Tuesday, Aug. 12 at 7 p.m. at the Rawlings Library, 100 E. Abriendo Ave., on the fourth floor in the InfoZone.

The discussion will include information on why the law was needed (citing multiple cases of military imposters), the need to develop a centralized database to honor true veterans, the Supreme Court case where it was ruled that the Stolen Valor Act was unconstitutional, the new law signed by President Obama and what changed with that law.
