## Summer Reading is here!

**PUEBLO, Colo.**– Faster than a speed reading competition, Summer Reading at the Pueblo City-County Library District is taking off full blast!

The Summer Reading program, *Every Hero Has a Story* is for readers of all ages, and there are ways for everyone to participate! Babies and toddlers, 0 to 4 years old, color in activity bubbles on their game board to earn prizes. Children, age 5 to 12, earn prizes after every five books, hours or days read. Teens, 13 and up participate in *Unmask!*, and play two different ways, either by reading or doing a task listed.

Adult readers have their own program, *Escape the Ordinary*. Just for signing up, they will receive a \$5 gift card to Books Again, PCCLD’s used book store. They also have the chance to win one of two Samsung Galaxy Tab 3 Lite Multi-Touch tablets or an Adventure Out! Gift Basket by reading five books.

The Summer Reading guide is available at any of the eight libraries throughout the district, or at the two satellite locations; each guide includes the children game board. The babies, teen and adult game boards are also available at the libraries.
