PUEBLO –Pueblo City-County Library District is giving away 2,000 free copies of *Maybe a Bear Ate It!*, by Robie H. Harris, to four year olds as part of the One Book 4 Colorado on April 18 through 29. The book is available in English and Spanish, is accessible to children with special needs. Books are available at the Barkman Library, 1300 Jerry Murphy Rd.; Lamb Library, 2525 S. Pueblo Blvd.; Pueblo West Library, 298 S. Joe Martinez, Pueblo West; and Rawlings Library, 100 E. Abriendo Ave. One Book 4 Colorado is a statewide effort to help instill a love of reading in Colorado’s children.

Books will be given away to the first 2,000 children during business hours, which are Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Friday through Saturday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.; and Sunday, noon to 5 p.m. at the Rawlings Library only.

One Book 4 Colorado is the result of collaborations between Reach Out and Read, Colorado State Library, public libraries, private sector groups and the foundation community. With this program, more than 70,000 copies of the same book will be distributed in Colorado.
