Award-winning Kurdish and German movie

Pueblo, Colo. – *Before Your Eyes*, the InfoZone News Museum’s independent film choice for August, is a drama from Turkey and Germany that follows a pair of young siblings whose parents are shot before their very eyes.

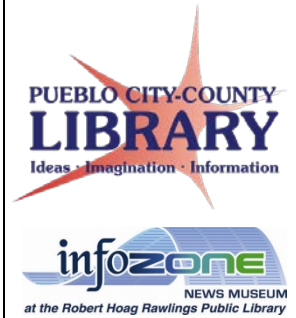
Ten-year-old Gulistan and her brother, Firat, live in the heart of Turkish Kurdistan. Tragedy strikes when their parents are killed by paramilitary gunmen in front of them. Traumatized and orphaned, Gulistan and Firat try to care for their infant sister, but their money soon runs out and they are forced onto the street. On the streets, Gulistan meets part-time escort Dilara. Gulistan is shocked to discover Dilara’s client is the murderer of her parents and quickly devises a plan for revenge.

Before Your Eyes will be shown at 7 p.m. on Saturday, Aug. 18. **Doors to the library open for movie attendees at 6:30 p.m., and the movie begins at 7 p.m.** *Before Your Eyes* is filmed in Turkish and Kurdish with English subtitles.

Independent films shown in the InfoZone are award-winning movies, honored at many notable festivals held each year around the world. The movies are works by up-and-coming directors from countries such as Canada, Brazil, India Denmark and Italy. The movies are not rated, and recommended for viewers ages 17 and older. Held on the third Saturday evening of each month, Independent Film Night is free to attend, and seating is on a first-come, first-served basis.

The InfoZone News Museum is a division of the Pueblo City-County Library District. All events are free and open to the public. The museum's mission is to provide broader knowledge of news and information. The museum focuses on journalism, the First Amendment, historic news and current events.
