Audit Engagement and Tax Form 990 Preparation (estimated time: 10 minutes)

- 2. Educational Assistance Policy 02.07.07 (estimated time: 10 minutes)

 OVERVIEW: The Board of Trustees is being asked to increase the maximum educational assistance for those eligible employees seeking a Master's degree in Library Science up to \$7,500 per calendar year and to increase the amount up to \$5,000 per calendar year for those eligible employees seeking a Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, or licensing or certification for an approved program.

- Colorado Family and Medical Leave Insurance (FAMLI) (estimated time: 10 minutes)

<u>OVERVIEW</u>: A report and recommendation was provided to the Trustees at their November 8th work session on this recent Colorado Law and how it pertains to

PCCLD. PCCLD plans to cover in full the .9% benefit cost.
