 On March 22, 2023, the Robert Hoag Rawlings Public Library marked the completion of a nearly two year renovation with a ribbon cutting ceremony. The grand re-opening of this facility provided a library to our community that will serve present as well as future needs.

#### Summer Reading by the Numbers

- 7,000 youth participants

The 2023 Summer Reading Program provided books to youth in our community, fun educational programs and great prizes to help children and teens enjoy reading and stay active during the summer months. This program engages children, teens and their parents, and helps to maintain and improve reading skills, and develop a love of reading.





#### All Pueblo Reads by the Numbers

All Pueblo Reads brought a whale of a good time ... or maybe it was really an octopus of a good time. All Pueblo Reads is a literary project that encourages everyone in Pueblo County to read and discuss the same book at the same time. The book chosen this year was *Remarkably Bright Creatures* by Shelby Van Pelt, the novel follows Tova Sullivan who works the night shift at an aquarium where she develops an unlikely bond with Marcellus, a giant Pacific octopus.





Our work to renew public libraries in Pueblo continues with our plans to renovate the Barkman and Lucero Libraries. The Frank & Marie Barkman Library serves the neighborhoods including Belmont, Pueblo's north side, Eastwood Heights and beyond. These two facilities will do the work of today's public library: serving as a vital community center, providing access to information and educational programming.
