## RFP # 1-2024--Category 1 Wide Area Network Services Questions & Answers

We would like to ask PCCLD the following questions for clarification regarding RFP 1-2024, Category 1 Wide Area Network Services for 470 240013143:

- 1. Section 8 "Scope of Work," Section 8.1. "The District is seeking WAN services for two branches, and or all branches... In order to provide a home run to the main branch"
  - a. The RFP identifies in Index A, two (2) sites, which site is considered the "main branch?"
    - i. The main site is Rawlings Public Library identified in Index B District Locations: as the (Hub Site), Rawlings Public Library 100 E. Abriendo Ave. Pueblo, CO 81004
  - b. Do you require both branches in Index A to be considered the main branch, thus having two main branches?
    - No, the idea is to get all branches on the Hub through 1 fiber network or to get only Index B connected on the 1 fiber network and then have a different fiber connection to Greenhorn Valley and Pueblo West.
  - c. RFP states a "point-to-point" home run to the main branch from each district branch, will PCCLD consider a WAN aggregation circuit at the main branch?
    - i. We would consider a link aggregation if possible.
- 2. Does the District have a set date by which the business will be awarded?
  - a. Business will be awarded by the board of trustees, expected Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> of February 2024. Notification will be sent out the following week.
- 3. Are you interested in other service options besides Layer 2 service for the leased-lit?
  - a. Our current environment operates on a layer 2 from branches back to our main hub. I would say that we would not be interested in other options unless they provide the same hub and spoke network ability as our current one.
