## Pride Month at PCCLD

A June 1969 uprising at the Stonewall Inn in Manhattan is often considered to be the beginning of the gay liberation movement in the United States. In June 1999, President Bill Clinton declared the anniversary of the Stonewall uprising every June as Pride Month in the United States.

Today, people around the world celebrate Pride to honor LGBTQIA+ people of the past, present and future. Look for a **#Pride** program at a library near you.

## Juneteenth: history and celebration

Juneteenth began as a celebration by the newly-freed persons more than 150 years ago in Galveston, Texas. Even though the Emancipation Proclamation freed enslaved persons in 1863, many places in the South did not enforce the proclamation until after the Civil War's end in 1865.

On June 19, 1865, Union Maj. Gen. Gordon Granger delivered General Order No. 3 that read in part, "The people of Texas are informed that, in accordance with a proclamation from the Executive of the United States, all slaves are free." Juneteenth – June and 19th – was celebrated by the newly freed a year later.

## PCCLD awarded \$250,000 for digital archiving

Pueblo City-County Library District was awarded a \$250,000 grant from the Mellon Foundation to go toward preserving the history and culture of communities throughout Southeastern Colorado through a digital archiving project.

Funds will go toward creating Regional Memory Labs, an archiving initiative that provides equipment and training free to users for do-it-yourself digitization of personal collections, allowing them to preserve recordings, documents, photos and video into a modern digital format.

A memory lab allows users to digitize:

- Photographs
- Photo and slide negative
- Documents
- Outdated video media, including 16mm film, 8mm, Super 8mm, VHS, VHS-C, S-VHS and MiniDV
- Audio cassettes
- 3.5-inch floppy disks and more

Users will also have access to recording equipment to capture oral histories. Once collections are digitized, owners keep their physical items from their collections.

#### About the project

The five-year project will allow for the creation of six permanent Satellite Memory Labs and five Mobile Memory Labs. The labs will be shared with partnering organizations within 16 counties, including: Alamosa, Baca, Bent, Conejos, Costilla, Crowley, Custer, Fremont, Huerfano, Kiowa, Las Animas, Otero, Prowers, Pueblo, Rio Grande and Saguache.

"History is made locally by ordinary people living in a place. One of our goals is to raise awareness of the principles of archiving and to help people understand that their personal and community histories are an important part of the cultural and historical landscape of Southeastern Colorado," Aaron Ramirez, PCCLD's manager of Local History and Genealogy said.

A lack of equipment and training to digitize personal collections often results in the loss of history and culture of the persons living in historically underrepresented regions like southeastern Colorado. Recording the histories of marginalized communities like Hispanic/Latino/a, African American and rural residents fill in the historical record of these missing voices.

#### **Regional Memory Labs**

Six permanent Satellite Memory Labs will be equipped to digitize photos, floppy disks, documents, film - including 16mm, 8mm and Super 8 — in addition to VHS video formats, as well as capture audio and visual. Users of the visiting Mobile Memory Labs will be able to scan photos, documents, capture audio and video. Organizations interested in applying to become a Regional Memory Lab can visit, www.pueblolibrary.org/ regionalmemorylab.

On-site training will be provided by PCCLD staff at both the satellite and mobile labs. Additionally, public archiving events will be held throughout the 16 county region to allow users to digitize their personal histories. Participants will also be able to donate their digital collections to a shared public digital archive, housed by PCCLD that will allow for greater access to once hidden collections. This will be the first digital archive of its kind in Southeastern Colorado.






