1. Describe the basis of your qualifications? List any financial, management, fundraising or other relevant background you may have.

I am an experienced corporate leader, Board Member, and nonprofit advocate. My professional experiences have included being the CFO of an energy technology company (Dynacloud), CFO of an energy investment fund (Wolf Resources), and Treasurer of a private energy company (Caerus Oil and Gas). Earlier in my career, I was an investment banker in NYC and participated in 45 capital markets transactions and mergers and acquisitions. As a CFO, I have led annual budgeting processes, strategic planning sessions, and capital raising initiatives. For nonprofits, I am a Board Member and Treasurer of Penguins International and a Mentor with the Rocky Mountain-Micro Finance Institute.

For Penguins International ("PI"), I have helped identify, evaluate, draft, and review applications to grantor programs for corporations and foundations. Additionally, for PI I participate in capital raising campaigns, event planning, and social media marketing initiatives. My professional experiences at Clarkson Platou Securities and Black Opal Equity included underwriting and structuring bond issuances similar to the C.O.P. financing and working extensively with investment bankers like to Hilltop and Stifel. At Caerus Oil and Gas and Wolf Resources, I helped raise +\$1 billion capital from institutional equity investors and debt financing from a syndicate of 15 lenders. Additionally, at each of these corporations I led the financial planning and analysis that invested over \$400 million annually into long term capital and development assets.

Two of my passions are education and animal conservation. I have made it a priority in my life to actively work with, and support, organizations that further these causes.
