Whether you are submitting a photo, The Chieftain of deliver them to a here are some guidelines:

- It doesn't matter if the photo is black and white or color. But it must be a clear, sharp photo, not a fuzzy photo, if it is to be used in the newspaper.

- Avoid photos of the subject that show her face, or is wearing sunglasses or a hat.

- The larger the photo, the better. It's easier to crop a large photo than a small one. Generally, the photo should be at least the size of a newspaper advertisement.
