Whether you are sending a photo or a card, The Chieftain offers these guidelines:

- It doesn't matter if the photo is black and white or color. But it must be sharp. If it's a fuzzy photo, it won't be published in the newspaper.

- Avoid photos of subjects who have a shadow over their face, or is wearing sunglasses or a hat.

- The larger the photo, the better. It's easier to fit a larger photo into the size of a photo frame. Generally, the photo should be at least the size of a photo frame.
