GUIDELINES

Grades 3-5: 400 word minimum, 700 word maximum.

Grades 6-12: 1,000 word minimum, 1,200 word maximum.

Do not place student's name on any page of story.

Provide one copy of entry with entry form on top.

All entries must be typed in 12 point type using *Times New Roman* or *Courier New* and double spaced.

Place title on top of first page - no title page needed.

Number each page.
