


Leadership Institute 2019 Application Form

Women in grades 10-12 are invited to apply to be part of the Leadership Institute, a fundraiser for the Pueblo Library Foundation. In this character-building program, participants learn about leadership, teamwork, volunteering and are presented as the next generation of leaders and philanthropists in Pueblo. This will be a life-changing opportunity to make friends, learn about leadership and impact the lives of Pueblo's citizenry through supporting the public library. The six-month institute culminates with Le Bal de Bibliotheque, a one-of-a-kind event where all participants will be publicly recognized for their accomplishments and introduced to the community.

Preference will be given to applicants with a 3.0 GPA or higher (but lower GPAs are considered with strong essay); have demonstrated high character; have demonstrated history of community service, school involvement or athletic participation; and aspire to a successful future. **Applications due by midnight Friday, Feb. 1, 2019** to Midori Clark at Rawlings Library, 100 E. Participation in the Leadership Institute requires attendance, or excused absence on a limited basis, at all meetings including: monthly workshops February through May 2019, and up to two event-planning meetings in June 2019. **Attendance at Le Bal de Bibliotheque on Saturday, July 13, 2019 is required.**

Should the applicant be accepted, there is a non-refundable presentation/activity fee of \$500 per participant to cover the cost of events leading up to and including Le Bal de Bibliotheque for the honoree. Payment options include a one-time payment of \$500 or a \$250 deposit by Friday, Feb. 1, 2019. If paying the \$250 deposit, the additional \$250 payment is due by Friday, March 1, 2019. Cash, check and credit cards accepted. Full and

partial scholarships are available. Scholarships are for financial need only. Fill out the additional scholarship application form and submit with this application for consideration.

Le Bal de Bibliotheque will be organized by the cohort with supervision by library staff. The cohort may choose to use the budget outlined by the Pueblo Library Foundation, or they may choose to self-fund the ball at a higher level. Additional costs associated with the ball include a formal gown, shoes, photos, family and friends' reservations to the ball, etc. Participants' cost to attend the ball is included in the participation fee. Additional ball reservations are \$75.
