

Pueblo’s Physical Distancing Outdoor Active Scavenger Hunt!

This scavenger hunt is adapted from a past PACE scavenger hunt when the Creative Corridor opened. This seemed like a fun way to get people outside being active and healthy while learning more about our own community as we stay close to home and limit the spread of COVID-19. This can be done solo with selfies or with a partner (TM-team member) maintaining the 6 foot minimum distance and a mask if closer or indoors.

- Rules:
- Be safe**, ride or walk defensively, do not assume motor vehicles see you. Follow the rules of the road. There are no prizes so don’t go crazy, this is just a fun way to explore safely. Participate at your own risk.
 - Limit the spread of COVID-19:** any of us could be infected and exhaling the virus and not know it. So pretend you are infected and limit spreading your germs in confined spaces or crowed trails. Keep a minimum of 6 feet from others and longer distance if you’re breathing hard, or yelling. When in more crowded outdoor areas or any indoor area, a mask is best.
 - Have fun exploring Pueblo!** A lot of good stuff to see in Pueblo and the “Safer at Home” order says we should stay closer to home.
