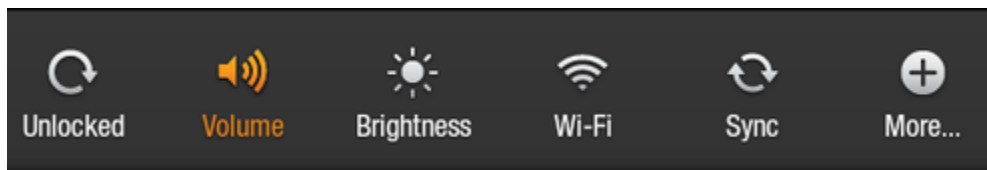




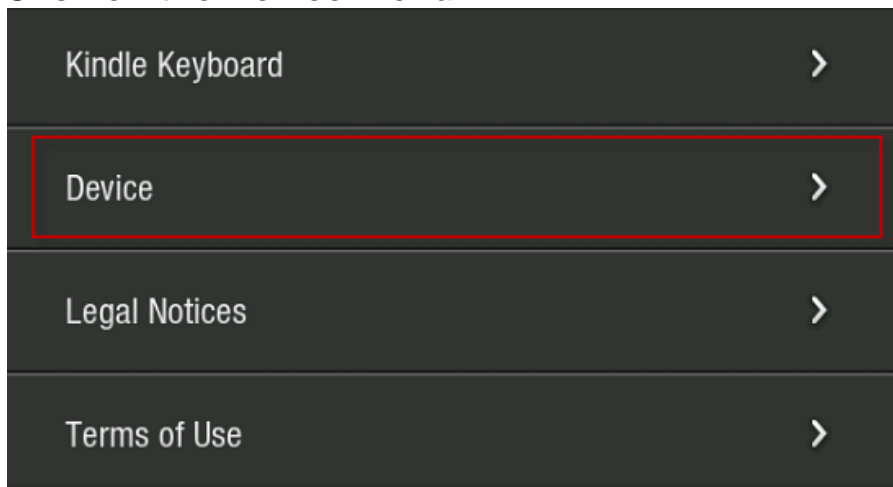
## Kindle Fire

Freeding is not compatible with many versions of the Amazon Kindle. The one exception to this is the Kindle Fire. It is possible to download an application that will allow the Kindle Fire to display the EPUB formatted books available in Freeding.

1. Go to the settings menu  on the Kindle Fire. Click on the More button to view all of the settings options.



2. Click on the Device menu.



3. Turn on the Allow Installation of Applications: From Unknown Sources.

**4. Go to the browser on your Kindle Fire and type in m.getjar.com.**

**5. You may be prompted to install the GetJar app at this point, tap 'download' if you are prompted. If not, search for 'getjar' on this site**

**6. Tap the download button to add GetJar to your Kindle Fire.**

**7. At the top of the Fire's screen you will now see a number with a circle around it (This is next to the name of the Kindle). Tap on this number to begin the installation procedure.**

**8. Once the installation is complete tap the Open button to launch the app.**

**9. Search for and download the Freading app. You will then need to install the Freading app following the same procedure as step 7.**

**10. Use Freading through the browser (go back to your library's Freading site) and download into the Freading app.**
