It is with great pleasure that I share with you the recent announcement by Library Journal that the Pueblo City-County Library District (PCCLD) has been chosen as a *Star Library*. Library Journal has used a special set of data measures as collected by the Institute for Museum and Library Services to rank U.S. public libraries. This selection places PCCLD among the top three percent of more than 9,300 public libraries in the country.

PCCLD is one of 260 libraries nationally that qualified as a *Star Library* and is the only library of its size in Colorado to be chosen as such. Dear Mr. Schilling:

It was a pleasure to present to the Pueblo City Council at your October 24 Council work session regarding the current state of your public library. I did some follow-up investigation on the costs for security services at the Lucero Library, since it came up as a topic of discussion at that meeting. I stated during the meeting that the 2017 budgeted amount for security service at the Lucero Library is approximately \$25,000. The actual amount is \$19,381.44.

It is not unusual for the library district to employ security services at its various library locations, as required, and the total budgeted amount for all library locations in 2017 is \$82,569.80. I am pleased that the more significant safety and security issues experienced at the Lucero Library earlier in 2015 have subsided significantly, and the current security costs are in line with expectations for other urban library locations in Pueblo (including both the Rawlings Library and the Barkman Library).

I attribute this positive change at the Lucero Library to the proactive work of library staff and partners, including, but not limited to, TNT Security, Hardknox Gang Prevention and Intervention Program, the Pueblo Police, and concerned citizens.

It also is important to acknowledge this library's vital service to the neighborhood it serves. My experience is that our programs there are as important, or more so, than in any other part of Pueblo. If use is any indication, this is most certainly true as the Lucero Library is our busiest given its size and hours of operation.

I thank you, again, for the opportunity to present to the City Council about the public library, and for your ongoing support for and work on behalf of this community.






