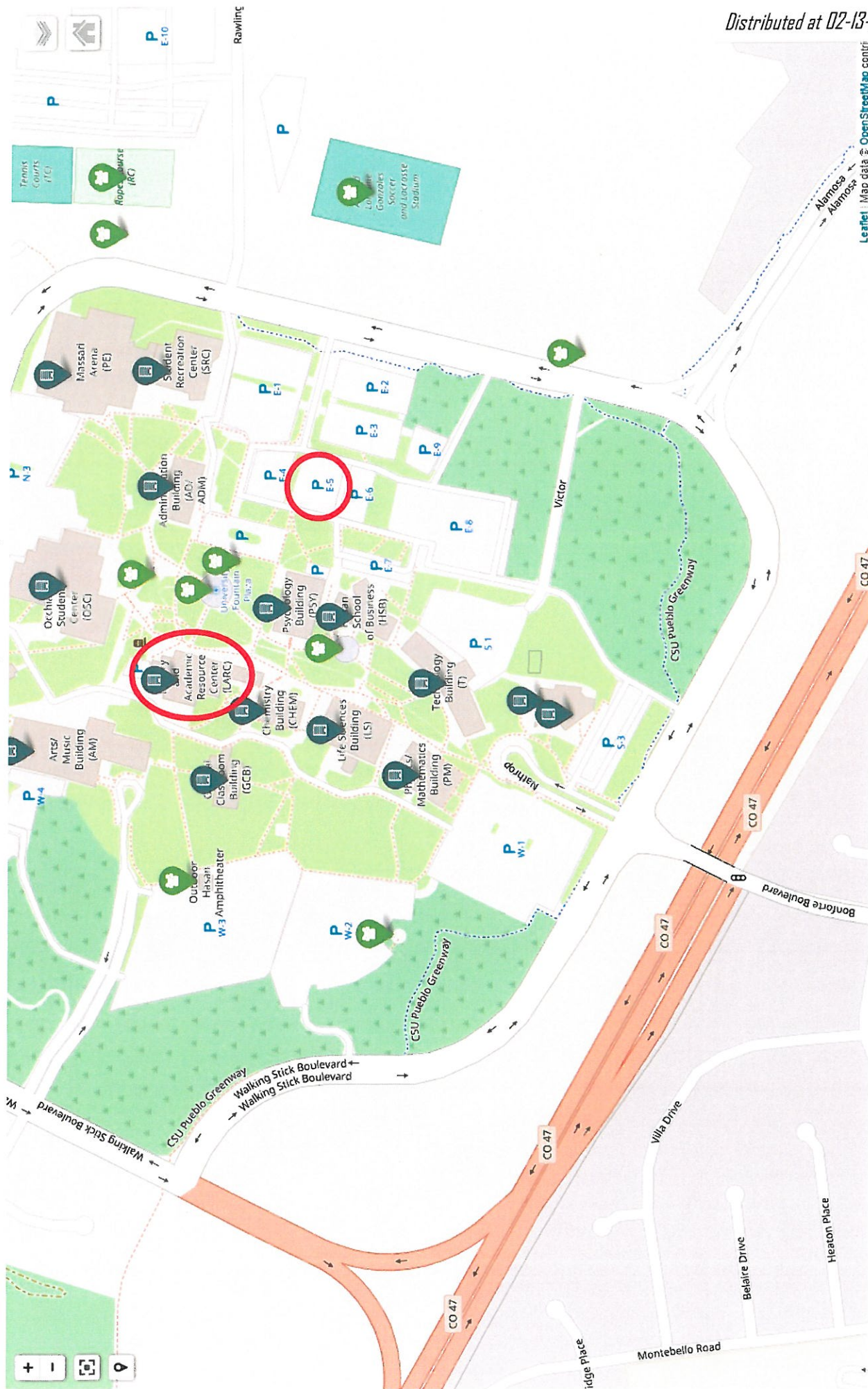

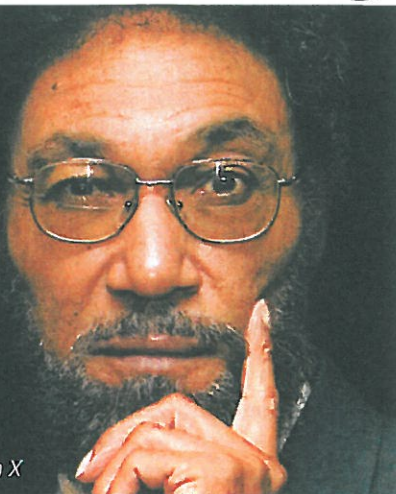
### Black History Live: Malcolm X Chautauqua
