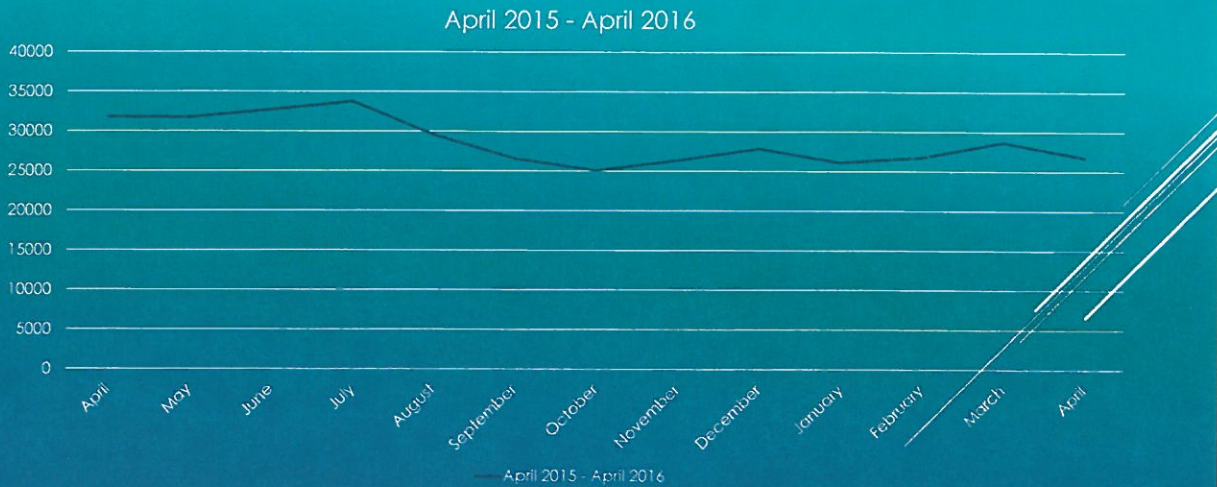

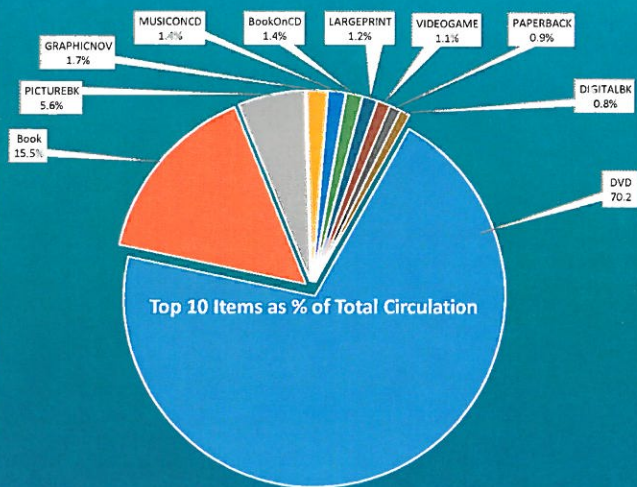

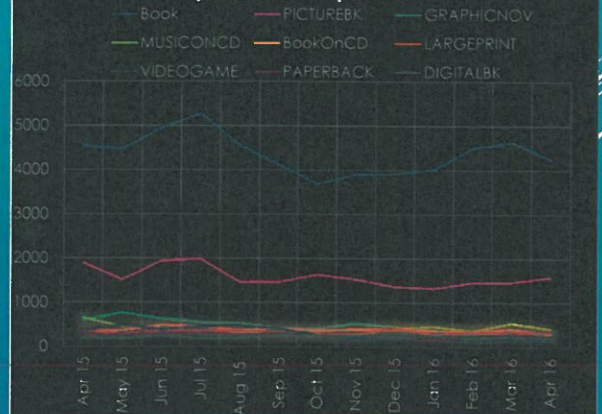
## CIRCULATION OF ALL MATERIALS BY MONTH APRIL 2015-APRIL 2016



## MAY 2014-APRIL 2015 CIRCULATION



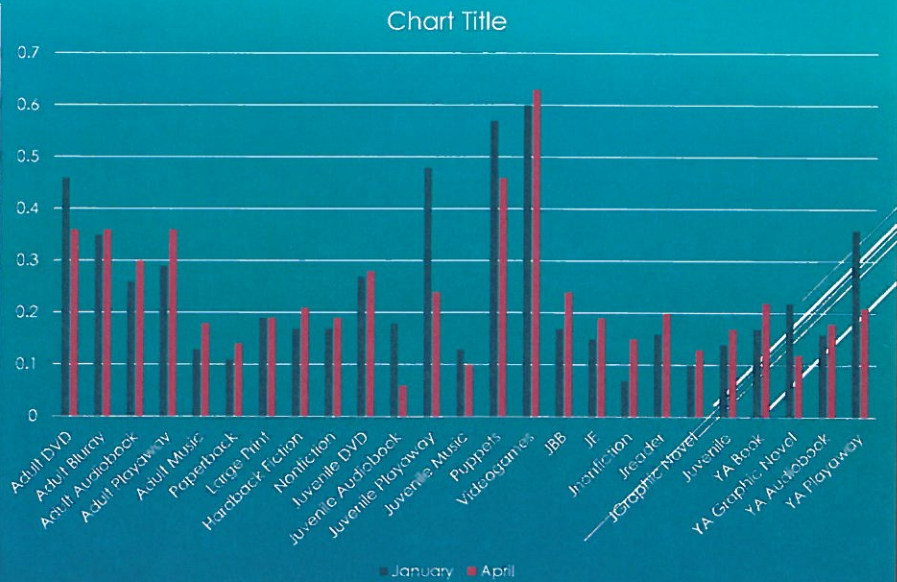
### Barkman Circulation Top 9 items Excluding DVDs April 2015 - April 2016



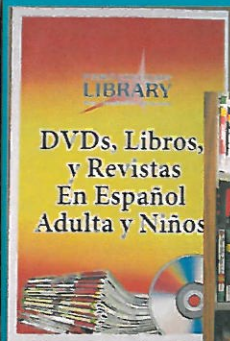

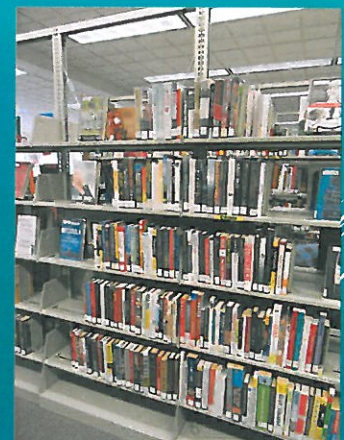
