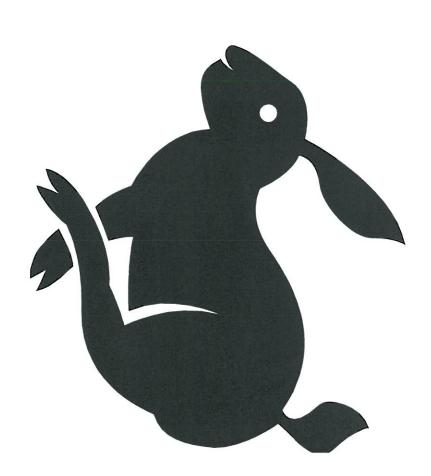

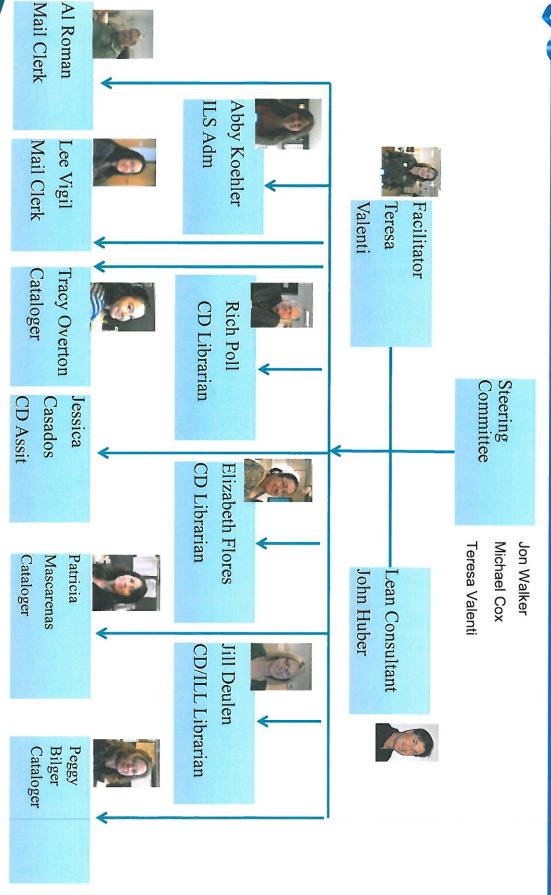

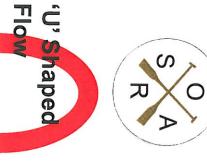
New Book SDC - Cross Functional Team



- Achieve less than a 5-day turnaround of all new books from dock to shelf for 95% of new items
- Eliminate expediting "hot" items and pursue a first in/first out approach to all items
- Improve the planning and coordination of selection vs. delivery to manage peak loads
- Improve the process flow and layout to eliminate staging areas, batching, and process flow imbalances
- Reduce batch sizes where possible
- Reduce redundant clerical activities where possible
- Optimize the use of the Technical Services floor space
- Improve the flow and visible management of the department
- Identify, evaluate, and justify potential outsourcing opportunities
- Support the addition of three new branches at reduced staffing
- Improve weeding efficiencies
- Prioritize the use and capability of current and new technology
- Improve capability to handle increased volumes of digital downloads and editing

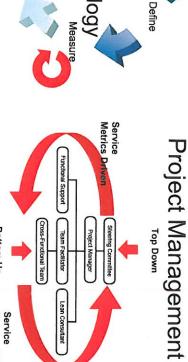










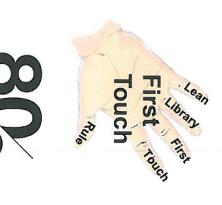

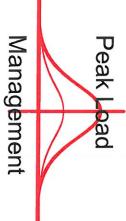
