

PCCLD Temporary Masking Policy

All individuals ages 2 years and older are required to wear face coverings over the nose and mouth while inside Pueblo City-County Libraries as recommended by the Pueblo Department of Public Health & Environment (PDPHE), the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE), and the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC). The masking requirement is to be applied in a manner consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act and related laws. The purpose of this measure is to help address the high number of positive COVID-19 cases currently in Pueblo County and to assist in maintaining a safe and healthy library environment. Failure of an individual to comply with this policy may result disciplinary action up to and including possible expulsion from the library and/or the loss of library privileges. This policy will be reviewed by the Pueblo City-County Library District Board of Trustees on a monthly basis to determine if conditions merit its continuation, modification, or rescission. The Executive Director or her/his designee is authorized to take action in accordance with any updated guidance and/or requirements of the PDPHE, CDPHE, and/or CDC with regard to masking and/or related matters and bring such action to the attention of the full Board of Trustees.
