
Recommendation for Request for Proposal for Self Checks

— Rawlings Renovation Project —

Project Overview

PCCLD solicited proposals from qualified vendors to provide six new self-checks at the Rawlings Library. In addition to the self-checks, PCCLD is seeking the cost for a five year service agreement to include annual licensing, support, and maintenance. This project is also coupled with a future self-check replacement plan for Barkman and Lucero's upcoming renovations. Vendors were asked to guarantee the same price for six additional self-checks in 2023.

RFP Committee included Nicki Lawless, Circulation Supervisor; Daniel Gaghan, ILS Administrator; Robert Childress, Director of IT; and Jill Kleven, Director of User Services.

Committee Notes

- Tech Logic** had the second highest cost and didn't meet all of the technical requirements.
- D Tech** had the lowest cost but there were two different machines proposed. If we went with the higher end machine, bid would have been higher. Support is international.
- Bibliotheca** has a proven track record at PCCLD, but had the highest cost.
- MK Solutions** is smaller company not in as many libraries. Was middle of the road with pricing. They do have a 98% success rate.
- FE Technologies** had a lot of features including econtent integration, gold level of service, an alert to allow staff to know when machine isn't working, and 95% success rate. One of the lower priced options.
