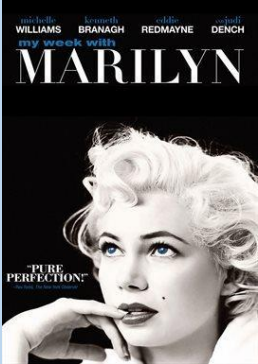

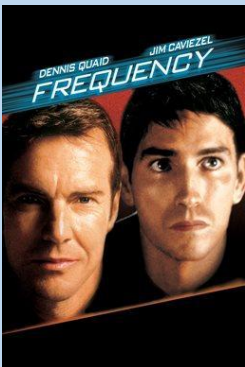
“My Week With Marilyn” (2011) (R) (Drama/Romance)

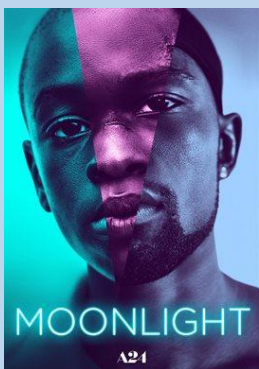
“Safe Haven” (2013) (PG-13) (Romance)
