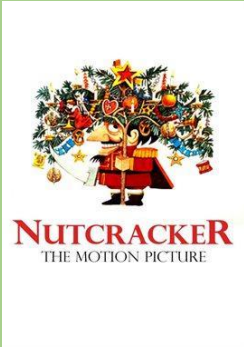




Hoopla Picks for December!



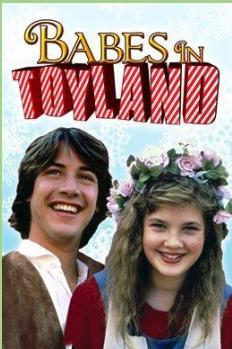
“Nutcracker: The Motion Picture” (1986) (G) (Family/Holiday)

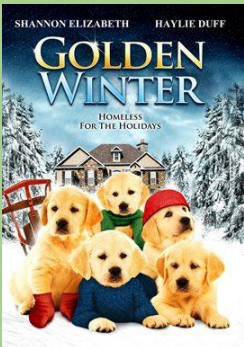
“Babes in Toyland” (1986) (G) (Family/Holiday)
