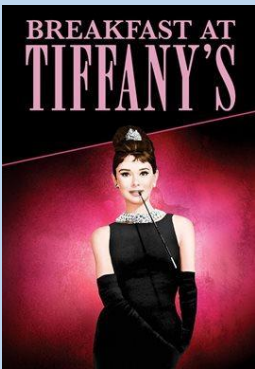
“The Score” (2001) (R) (Drama)

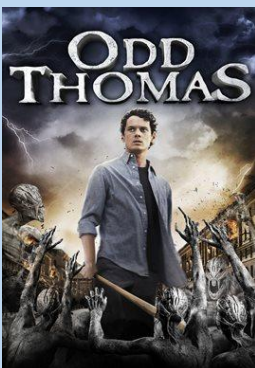
“Breakfast At Tiffany's” (1961) (NR) (Comedy)

“Odd Thomas” (2014) (PG-13) (Suspense)

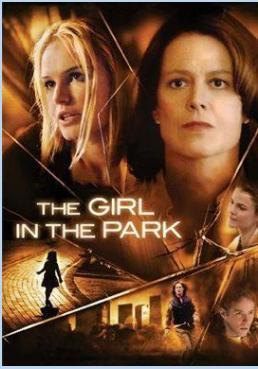


In a California desert town, a short-order cook with clairvoyant abilities encounters a mysterious man with a link to dark, threatening forces.

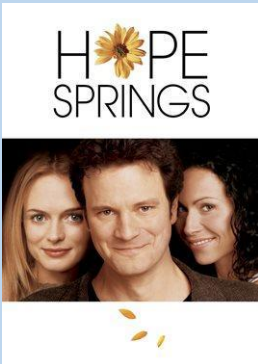
“The Girl In The Park” (2008) (R) (Drama)

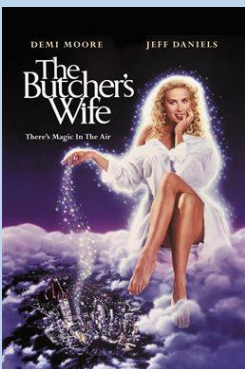
“Hope Springs” (2003) (PG-13) (Romance)
