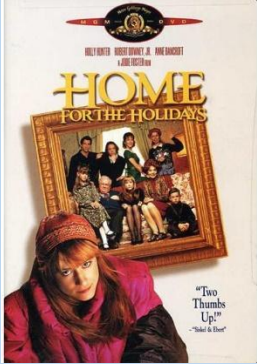




Kanopy Picks for December!



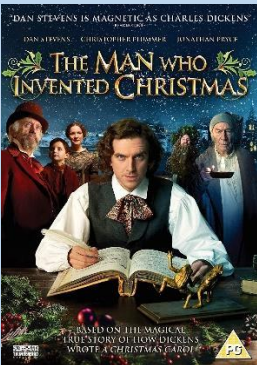
“Home for the Holidays” (1995) (PG-13) (Comedy/Drama)

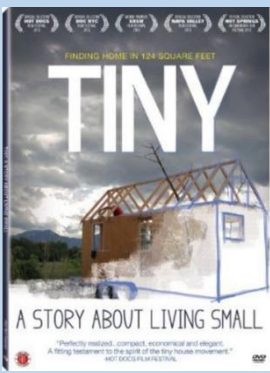
“Drop City” (2012) (Documentary)
