MODULE 1

Interpreting Life and Mental Health

Life is stressful and can get messy, no matter who you are. This module will help students to make sense of life by providing helpful tools, resources and skills. Participants will learn how to practice mindfulness as well as how to manage emotions.

MODULE 2

Financial Literacy

Everyone wants to be able to manage their money and be self-sufficient. This unit helps learners understand how to effectively manage their personal finances, including budgeting, developing a spending and savings plan, understanding credit and learning how to invest in the future. Participants will develop a stronger understanding of basic financial concepts to manage money better.

MODULE 3

Identify and Harness Strengths and Weaknesses

We all have things we like and things we are good at, students will learn how to identify these attributes and harness them to better their future. This module will help participants discover career possibilities, educational interests and personal goals.

MODULE 4

How to Envision the Future

How do students know what they want to be in 5,10,15 years? Planning for education, career and future goals can cause stress for many. This module will help students develop a plan that can be used as a road map to understanding where they are currently and what actions need to be taken to achieve the future self that they envision.

This year-long program is taught by area professionals and offers participants lifelong skill sets to develop them into leaders.

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
