

Otis Glass Dies At 85

Otis R. Glass, 85, of 1327 E. Third, died Sunday in a local hospital after being ill for about three weeks. A resident of Pueblo since 1891, he was born June 24, 1876, in Gardner, Ill.

Glass enlisted during the Spanish American War and served with Company E of the Colorado infantry volunteers. He was an employe of the Denver & Rio Grande Western Railroad for 47 years, before retiring as a locomotive engineer.
