Named in first-degree murder charges were James E. Wallace, 15, of 621 Greenwood and Patrick R. Martinez, 18, of 2104 E. 12th. Reindicted in the same amended information was Charles D. Salazar, 17, of 1205 E. Fifth, originally the sole announced suspect in the case.

The murder charges arose from an incident at an area 7-Eleven Store in which Bernard Meehan, an alleged armed robber, shot and killed the policeman. Hanson's partner, James Askey, shot Meehan to death mo-
