MLKIII and Yotam Ottolenghi featured authors at PCCLD

Human rights advocate Martin Luther King III and awardwinning chef and New York Times Bestselling author Yotam Ottolenghi will be the featured authors at Pueblo City-County Library District. In order to observe public health guidelines, both King and Ottolenghi's presentations are virtual and will be streamed live on the library district's Facebook and YouTube pages.

The eldest son of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., King is the featured speaker of the library district's adult summer learning series, Community Voices. This series is a celebration of the diverse populations that have called Pueblo and Southern Colorado home during the past 100 plus years. Starting in August the library district is producing a

10-part series that spotlights the stories and achievements of the African American community in and around Pueblo.

Capping off Community Voices, King will give a virtual presentation at 10 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 16. This is free and

open to the public, streaming on the library district's Facebook and YouTube pages.

Moving into the fall, the library district's annual All Pueblo Reads features internationallyrenown chef and author Yotam Ottolenghi. Co-author of 10 internationally-bestselling cookbooks, "Flavor" is the centerpiece of this year's county-wide literacy project. Co-authored with Ottolenghi Test Kitchen's lxta Belfrage, the 100 plus recipe, plant-based cookbook "Flavor" demystifies the process of creating flavor in main courses through to desserts.

His virtual public author talk is 11 a.m. on Saturday, Nov. 6. As a twist on the traditional author talk, online viewers can cook brunch along with Ottolenghi, as he discusses his work both in and out of the kitchen.

To commemorate the celebration of food, family and fun, the district will produce a community cookbook, a compilation of family recipes submitted by Pueblo County and Southern Colorado residents.


