YOUR FUTURE LIBRARY

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

The Robert Hoag Rawlings Public Library stands as a majestic facility in central Pueblo dedicated to lifelong learning and literacy. This bustling library has hosted more than eight-million visitors since it first opened to the public in 2003. More than 14-million books and other materials have been checked-out from the Rawlings Library over the course of its nearly two decades of service to Pueblo's citizens. This library is well used and a project currently is underway to refresh the 110,000 sq. ft. facility so it is ready to meet the demands of a busy future.

The all-in cost to rejuvenate the Rawlings Library is over \$11 million including design, construction, and furniture, fixtures, and equipment. The good news is more than \$10 million is available now for the project. This money consists of a combination of public and private contributions. A funding gap remains and there is an active campaign now to raise the remaining money necessary to ensure the successful completion of the project. Please donate to this important work.

The goal of the Rawlings Library renovation project is focused on refurbishing the interior of this striking facility along with limited site work so its upcoming years of service will as positively impact Pueblo as the previous twenty years. Architectural design for the update is complete and it includes significant input from community stakeholders. This effort is being led by AMD Architects, the team who originally designed the building over twenty years ago. AMD is collaborating now on the current renovation with HBM Architects, a firm nationally-renowned for producing recent state-of-the-art public libraries in locations across the United States. Construction documents are being finalized now and the twelve months needed to finish the job is scheduled to commence upcoming in August and wrap-up in July 2022. Construction will be managed by Pueblo's H. W. Houston Construction.

This update to the Rawlings Library is important for our community. It has both symbolic and utilitarian aims. It represents Pueblo's ongoing commitment to the vital American values of free and open access for everyone in support of reading, knowledge, and information. The project is practical, too. Citizens from all walks of life and all ages will have access for years to come to a beautiful and comfortable place to gather together to study and learn. The importance of this is perhaps best put in these words attributed to Thomas Jefferson: "An educated citizenry is a vital requisite for our survival as a free people."

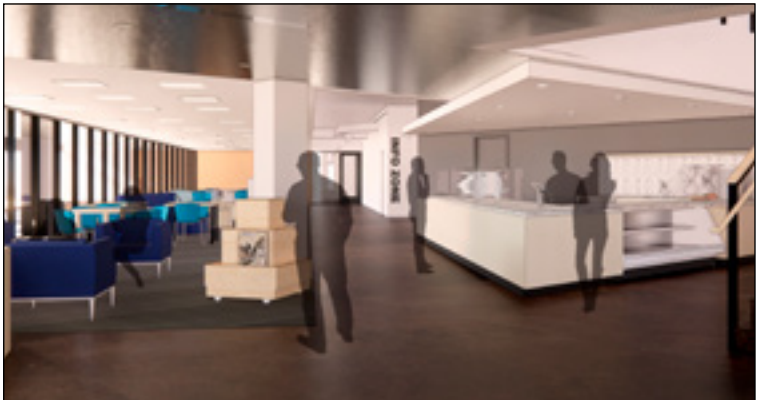
Reimagined Courtyard and Mobility Plaza

FIRST FLOOR & SITE WORK

The outdoor site work plans call for a major redesign, including a mobility plaza to be used for better access to the main entrance as well as eliminate Bates Lane that runs under the Rawlings Library skybridge.

Eliminating this road will allow for more accessibility to

the public library by creating a pedestrian-friendly program and event space, as well as an opportunity to add additional handicap parking and increased mobility to and from the main entrance. Creation of a mobility plaza and closer parking will improve accessibility and equity in access to the building.



First Floor Cafe & Museum Entrance

The First Floor improvements provides additional meeting rooms, an expanded maker space, more visible museum and exhibit space, and an operational cafe with reading lounge area. These improvements to the

building allow for increased engagement to occur, providing opportunities to enhance the vitality of the community, as well as enhance a public facility that serves as an educational resource for children, teens and families.

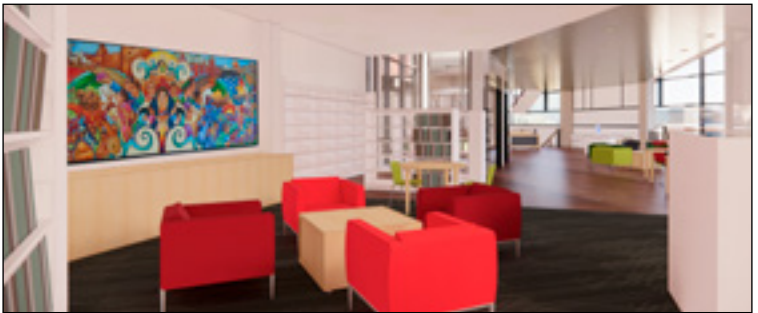
Youth Services Entrance

SECOND FLOOR

The Second Floor of the library transforms into a hub for all age groups. This floor provides the traditional library services of books, movies, materials, as well as study and collaboration spaces.

A major change to this floor

is the inclusion of children's services. Moving children's services to the Second Floor allows for a safer and more imaginative area, creating an environment for youth and families to enjoy reading a book or taking part in a storytime.



Hispanic Resource Center

THIRD FLOOR

The Third Floor changes provide for an enlarged Hispanic Resource Center as well as an expanded and improved archives vault to house regionally significant artifacts.

The Rawlings Library archives collection contains 41,972 catalogued items and an estimated 57,130 unique items,

many of which are significant to Hispanic origins in the region, state and local history and regional genealogy. A renovated space will provide for larger, more adequate archives storage as well as digitization equipment so patrons can catalogue and chronicle their individual histories.

FOURTH FLOOR

The Fourth Floor renovation becomes a grand event space. This allows for larger community gatherings, events and celebrations. The grand ballroom can host between 320

to 500 people in a given event. With its expansive views of the mountains and city of Pueblo, this space will be a sophisticated and beautiful venue for any community event.
