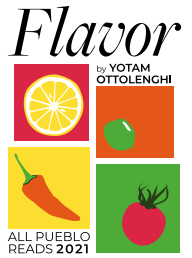

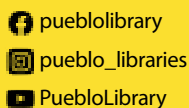

All Pueblo Reads is a literary program designed to get everyone in Pueblo County reading and discussing one book at the same time each year. The goals of the project are to promote literacy and encourage community dialog across social, cultural and generational lines.

Chef and author Yotam Ottolenghi, featured author for All Pueblo Reads

Pueblo City-County Library District's annual All Pueblo Reads features internationally-renown chef and bestselling author Yotam Ottolenghi. Co-author of 10 internationally-bestselling cookbooks, *Flavor* is the centerpiece of this year's county-wide literacy project. *Flavor* is a 100-plus recipe cookbook that serves up plant-based dishes as the star of full-course meals — from appetizers, to main course to desserts. Ottolenghi and his co-author and chef Ixta Belfrage go beyond mere ingredient lists to explain in depth how the elements of process, pairing and produce selection co-mingle to create flavorful dishes. Process explains the methods — such as infusing and charring — can elevate ingredients. Pairings of sweet, acidity, fat and chile heat unlock flavor. Finally, identifying the ideal produce to use in a given dish.

For the celebrated chef, writer, and restaurateur, food is about more than what we eat. It is about joy, pleasure, and surprise. It is about a sense of place and home. It is about commonality, an act which brings people together. He has stated, "It's tragic that we are so good at adapting ourselves to different cuisines and enjoy being super international, yet we are not able to apply the

same level of tolerance to the actual people that cook them."

The district's annual Booklovers Ball takes on a relaxed air with 2021's virtual Booklovers Brunch. Mindful of public health guidelines, this year's district fundraiser is again virtual and will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, Nov. 6. Attendees can cook brunch along the award-winning chef and have exclusive access to ask questions during the Q&A portion of the event. Virtual passes and viewing kits are available for purchase at www.pueblolibrary.org/bookloversbrunch. Each

viewing kit contains: a Virtual Event Pass, a copy of *Flavor*, signed by Yotam Ottolenghi, ingredients for Saturday's brunch, a mimosa kit and a choice of gourmet dessert.

A virtual public conversation with Ottolenghi will take place at noon on Sunday, Nov. 7, streaming on the Pueblo Library Facebook and YouTube pages. This event is free.

Ottolenghi's debut cookbook, *Ottolenghi*, co-authored with Tamimi, was published in 2008. More volumes followed: a collection of recipes exploring the flavors of his home-city, *Jerusalem* (2012); the vegetable cookbooks *Plenty* (2010) and *Plenty More* (2014); a cookbook from his London restaurant, *Nopi* (2015); a dessert cookbook, *Sweet* (2017); and *Ottolenghi Simple* (2018) and his latest book *Flavor* (2020).

Ottolenghi Test Kitchen will release new cookbook *Ottolenghi Test Kitchen: Shelf Love* in October.

His books have been named among the best books of the year by the *New York Times*, *San Francisco Chronicle*, and NPR. A documentary film, *Ottolenghi and the Cakes of Versailles*, was released in 2020.

Kids companion book and author

Award-winning author Vicki Cobb, known as the "Master Chef of Hands-on Science," is a former science teacher. Her book, *Science Experiments You Can Eat*, is a playful, hands-on take on science. Her books for grades kindergarten through eighth grade cover topics such as physics, chemistry and biology, biographies, geography, and the human body.

She has performed "Science Surprises," for students throughout the U.S. Cobb shares her expertise, humor and wit to inspire teachers to make science teaching the highpoint of their

day.

Her featured book *Science Experiments You Can Eat* is a hands-on book of edible science experiments. Updated information that reflects changes in the world of processing and preserving foods, this cookbook demonstrates the scientific principles that underpin the chemical reactions witnessed every day — just by cooking.

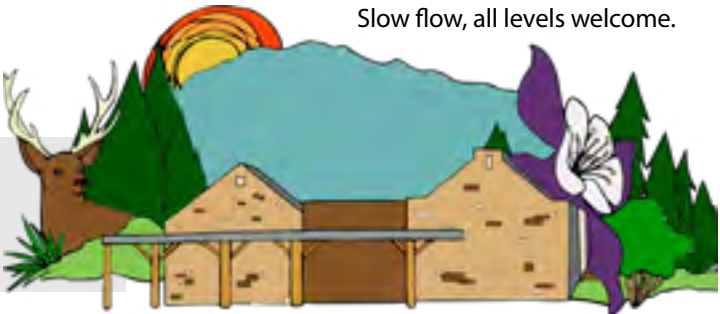
