Community Voices featuring Martin Luther King III

Martin Luther King III is our featured speaker for Community Voices, a series celebrating the diverse populations that have called Pueblo and Southern Colorado home during the past 100 plus years. He will speak during a free, virtual event at 10 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 16, streaming on the Pueblo Library Facebook and YouTube pages. The eldest son of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., King serves as an ambassador of his parent's legacy of nonviolent social change. A graduate of his father's Alma mater, Morehouse College, King has devoted his life to working in the non-profit sector to promote civil rights and global human rights and to eradicate the "triple evils" of racism, militarism and poverty his father identified as the scourges of humankind. In addition to his civil rights work, King authored a children's picture book My Daddy, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. This unique memoir offers an intimate insight into the man and the father who was a prominent leader of the civil rights movement. 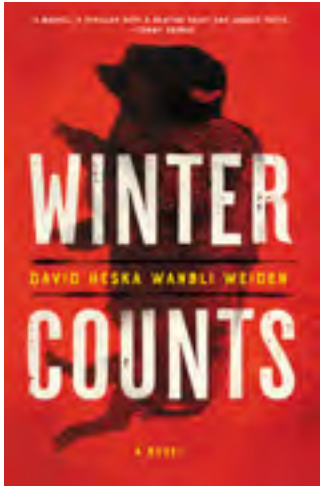

RAWLINGS RENOVATION TIMELINE

Rawlings Library will remain open during renovations, however there may be some service disruptions. We apologize for any inconvenience.

RENOVATION TIMELINE:

Project is slated to start mid August

Phase 1: Summer/Fall 2021  
Outdoor site work  
First floor including Youth Services, meeting rooms, Circulation

- Youth Services moves to the fourth floor
- Meeting rooms are refreshed
- Circulation area is renovated
- New Makerspace area is constructed

Phase 2: Winter/Spring 2022  
Second floor

- South wing/skywing to house adult fiction and nonfiction
- East wing (former nonfiction

- area) becomes the new Teen Zone
- North wing (former Teen Zone) becomes Youth Services area

Phase 3: Spring 2022  
Third floor  
Hispanic Resource Center now has larger, permanent home  
Archive vault is expanded  
Study rooms are added

Phase 4: Summer 2022  
Fourth floor  
Entire floor becomes a larger event space



Renovations to Rawlings Library underway

Renovations to the first floor are well underway. The area currently under construction include the former home of Youth Services department, the area that soon be home to the InfoZone Museum and cafe area. Youth Services is now located in the Ryals Room on the fourth floor. "This bustling library has hosted more than eight-million visitors since it first opened to the public in 2003. This library is well used and a project currently is underway to refresh the 110,000 square-foot facility so it is ready to meet the demands of a busy future," stated Jon Walker, the library district's executive director. Overall cost of the renovations is more than \$12.5 million; the price tag includes design, construction, furniture, fixtures and equipment. Renovations will primarily focus on refurbishing the interior of the five-floor public building along with exterior site will include an outdoor amphitheater and expanded parking.
