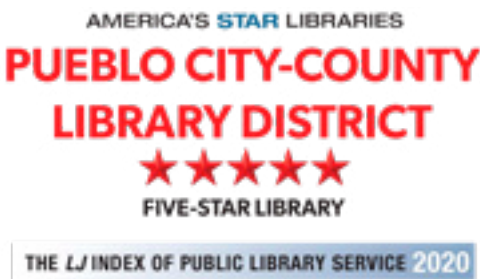

Pueblo is home to a Five-Star Library

Your library is now nationally recognized as a Five-Star Library! PCCLD earned the distinction of Five Star Library status for 2020 by the Library Journal. This is the first time PCCLD has been awarded the top status during the five consecutive years of being named a star library. The Library Journal Index of Public Library Service was created to recognize and promote excellent public libraries in America. Of the 5,608 U.S. public libraries that qualified to be rated, 262 were named Star Libraries.



Your Pueblo library district is one of only 85 libraries in the U.S. to be awarded Five Star Status.

How did you help us get here? To be a Star Library, each library is rated per capita on: circulation, items checked out electronically, visits, program attendance, public computer users, Wi-Fi sessions and database usage. PCCLD rated highest in program attendance and Wi-Fi usage. Library Journal is the oldest and most respected professional library publication. Finally fine free: most items have no overdue fines

During January PCCLD eliminated overdue fines on books, audiobooks, magazines, DVDs and music CDs. This means you can return your materials a few days past the due date without worrying about growing overdue fines. However, you are still responsible for returning the item. If an item is not returned 30 days past its due date, you are responsible for paying a replacement cost as well as a \$5 processing fee. If you return the

item after that 30 days, you aren't responsible for the replacement cost but you are still charged the processing fee. Do note, there are a few exceptions to fine free that include: tablets, Chromebooks, internet hotspots, community passes and Interlibrary Loan materials. The Life and Work of Frank D. Muramoto

The Special Collections and Museum Services Department created the Muramoto exhibit because the life and work of Frank "Duke" Denichi Muramoto (1884-1958) is significant and should be celebrated. Muramoto was a first generation immigrant, Issei from Yamaguchi Prefecture, Japan, arriving at the Port of San Francisco at the turn of the 20th century. Through hard work on the Union Pacific Railroad in Wyoming, and on farms in Colorado and Texas, he put himself through photography school at the Illinois College of Photography at Effingham, a cutting-edge institution. He worked in Spring Green, Wisconsin for architect Frank Lloyd Wright at a time when construction of Wright's Taliesin estate was coming to completion.

photographer. His camera work extended into his personal and social life, as he filmed and photographed gatherings of fellow Japanese Methodists and documented trips and gatherings with friends and family in Pueblo and abroad.

The Muramoto films are priceless insights into the world of Frank Muramoto, his family, and friends. The PCCLD Special Collections and Museum Services Department holds seven film reels created by Muramoto in the late 1930s. They are silent, and

Muramoto's photography reflects the diversity of Pueblo. People of all ethnicities and races sat for portraits. Outside of the studio, Muramoto captured clubs, religious groups and served as a school

contain 16mm black and white and color film. An interesting feature is that Muramoto filmed intertitle cards in Japanese and English that describe the following scenes. The films document a wide range of subjects of interest: the Muramoto's explore the Mesa Verde Cliff Dwellings, the construction of the San Isabel Dam, a newly WPA constructed "Monkey Mountain" and animal enclosures at the Pueblo Zoo, the Colorado State Fair and parade through downtown Pueblo, the Great Sand Dunes National Park, the Pueblo Mountain Park and its lodge, agriculture in southern Colorado, scenes of fellowship among southern Colorado Japanese, and a spectacular demonstration of exercises and feats of strength

by Mr. Kitahata. Through a generous grant from the National Film Preservation Foundation, we were able to create preservation copies of the films, along with digital scans, available globally on the web.

The Muramoto exhibit was the product of SCMS staff research and collaboration with the Pueblo County Historical Society, who allowed us to scan copies from their vast collection of Muramoto photographs. In support of the exhibit and films, we partnered with cultural groups and scholars from across Colorado and the United States to provide historical context and insight into the Japanese-American experience that Muramoto lived.

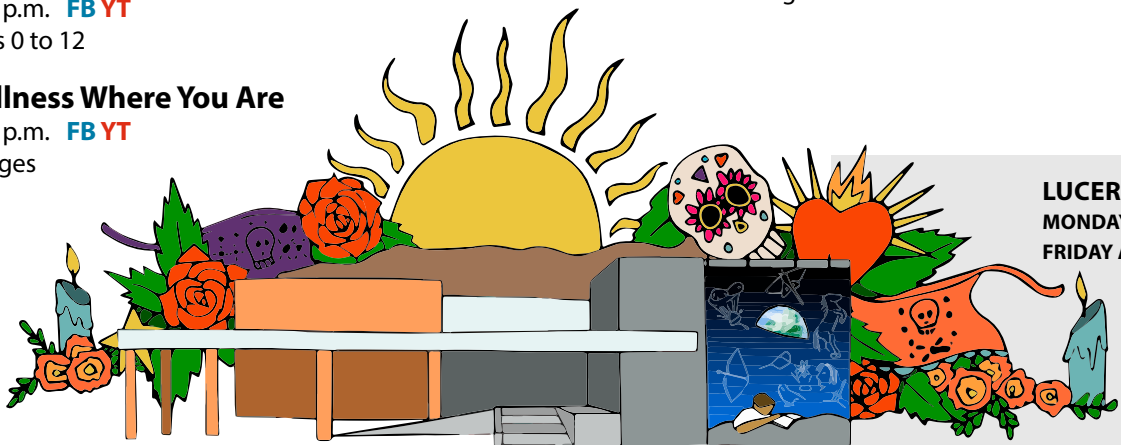
